CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARTHUR O. AND ISOBEL TOLLEFSON  
27023 LOWER SMITH RIVER ROAD  
REEDSPORT, OR 97467

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING AND SMITH RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44289. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FROM THE SPRING FOR DOMESTIC USE, AND 0.02 CFS FROM SMITH RIVER FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.; 2220 FEET NORTH AND 200 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 31.

RIVER: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.; 80 FEET NORTH AND 1580 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC  
SECTION 31  
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
