CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING AND AN UNNAMED STREAM, tributaries of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY AND IRRIGATION OF 1.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50642. The date of priority is MAY 9, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE FROM THE SPRING WHEN AVAILABLE, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY AT THE SPRING TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM, AND 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION FROM THE UNNAMED STREAM WHEN AVAILABLE, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM THE SPRING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING - LOT 16 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, WM; 950 FEET NORTH AND 1050 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 2; AND

STREAM - LOT 16 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, WM; 780 FEET NORTH AND 1150 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


LOT 16 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)
SECTION 2
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
