confirms the right to use the waters of QUARTZ SPRING, a tributary of QUARTZ CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK USE (9 RV SPACES).

This right was perfected under Permit 51495. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.015 CFS FOR RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARK USES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.; 250 FEET NORTH AND 640 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 16 EAST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
