CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MARLIN LARSEN
160 RIVERSHORE DRIVE
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.3 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 50800. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.034 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.029 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 2770 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4	1.4 ACRE AND DOMESTIC
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	0.4 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN M. TIPTON DLC 39	
LOT 4 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)	0.5 ACRE
SECTION 13	
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.	

The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the diversion. The required screen is to be in place, functional, and approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
