CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51068. The date of priority is MAY 25, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. **Use of water is limited to irrigation of up to one-half acre noncommercial garden from July 15 through September 30 each year.**

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. FINCH DLC 42, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 2370 FEET SOUTH AND 990 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.5 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. FINCH DLC 42
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
