## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LAWRENCE D. OR AGNES R. AAMOT 3048 LITTLE RIVER ROAD GLIDE, OR 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of FALL CREEK AND LITTLE RIVER, tributaries of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 3.5 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 51311. The date of priority is AUGUST 6, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.049 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.015 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE FROM FALL CREEK AND 0.029 CFS FOR IRRIGATION FROM LITTLE RIVER, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

FALL CREEK - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 260 FEET SOUTH AND 1390 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 32;

LITTLE RIVER - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 170 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.3 ACRES NW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.2 ACRES AND DOMESTIC SECTION 32

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
