CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WESTERN NATIONAL LEASING, INC.
P.O. BOX 730
CANYONVILLE, OR 97417

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING, a tributary of PERDUE CREEK (SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER), for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN.

This right was perfected under Permit 51178. The date of priority is AUGUST 10, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The use of water is limited to human consumption, watering livestock necessary for the sustenance of a family and irrigation of up to one-half acre non-commercial garden from July 15 through September 30 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4, SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 1091 FEET NORTH AND 813 FEET WEST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
