CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD AND IRRIGATION OF 1.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51618. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 14, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.032 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.022 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. THE USE OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION IS LIMITED TO THE PERIOD OF MARCH 1 THROUGH OCTOBER 31 OF EACH YEAR. THE USE OF WATER FOR DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED IS ALLOWED YEAR-ROUND.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN C. REED DLC 47, SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 230 FEET SOUTH AND 1010 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.8 ACRES AND DOMESTIC
AS PROJECTED WITHIN C. REED DLC 47
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation

period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

- B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife specifications.

The water user shall not construct, operate or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage in the channel of the subject stream.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
