CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ARTHUR C. MILLER

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE OF TWO FAMILIES AND IRRIGATION OF 4.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32713. The date of priority is JULY 3, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.01 CFS FOR DOMESTIC AND 0.05 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$), SW $\frac{1}{4}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN AMSLER DLC 51, SECTION 25, T 30 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1960 FEET SOUTH AND 80 FEET WEST; 1930 FEET SOUTH AND 980 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF AMSLER DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

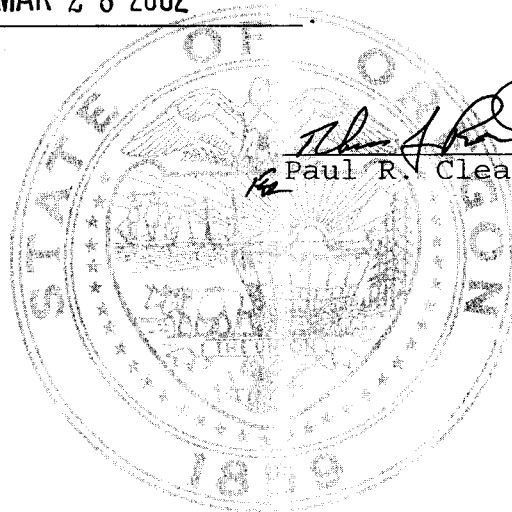
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 40077, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 2 8 2002, approving Transfer Application 8120.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
