CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the DESCHUTES BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 158.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9688. The date of priority is JULY 16, 1981. This right is limited to 1.98 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE ¼ NW ¼, SECTION 29, T 13 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 30 FEET SOUTH AND 2050 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW ¼ NE ¼	39.8 ACRES
SW ¼ NE ¼	39.6 ACRES
NE ¼ NW ¼	39.4 ACRES
SE ¼ NW ¼	39.4 ACRES

SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.


The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
