CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BONNEVILLE POWER ADMINISTRATION
PO BOX 3621
PORTLAND, OREGON 97208

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the COLUMBIA RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USES (BACK-UP AND EMERGENCY SOURCE FOR COOLING WATER AND DRINKING WATER AT THE CELILO D.C. CONVERTER STATION).

This right was perfected under Permit G-10590. The date of priority is DECEMBER 16, 1985. This right is limited to 1.11 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 6, T 1 N, R 14 E, W.M.; 1820 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

W 1/2 SE 1/4
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 14 EAST, W.M.


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.
