CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DELMER EUGENE AND ELLEN TERRY DAVIS
65745 TWIN BRIDGES ROAD
BEND, OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 3.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11018. The date of priority is JANUARY 22, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The well is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 17, T 16 S, R 12 E, W.M.; 522 FEET SOUTH AND 213 FEET WEST FROM C 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.8 ACRES
SECTION 17
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior surface or ground water rights.
