CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LA CASA MIA ASSOCIATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
PO BOX 364
REDMOND, OREGON 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS NO.'S 1 AND 2 in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for QUASI-MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11285. The date of priority is DECEMBER 28, 1990. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL NO. 1 - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.; 2600 FEET NORTH AND 1250 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31; AND

WELL NO. 2 - NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.; 1790 FEET NORTH AND 1670 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 SE 1/4
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.


This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior surface or ground water rights.
