CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD D. SIMPSON  
2090 WATERS CREEK RD.  
WILDERVILLE, OR 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of WATERS CREEK, a tributary of SLATE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 11.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 4252. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL AUTHORIZED POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.; 990 FEET NORTH AND 2970 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 37 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.; 1320 FEET SOUTH AND 590 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 21, 1996, and supersedes the portion of Certificate 3431 State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT CANCELED BY ORDER ENTERED DECEMBER 14, 1995 in Volume 49, Pages 531 and 532, SPECIAL ORDER OF THE WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
