CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUGLAS AND JANET BITTER 581 QUAIL LANE ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 11.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 9500. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 10, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN BROWN DLC 54, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 1140 FEET SOUTH AND 1700 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 11.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITH BROWN DLC 54
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 19, 1997, and together with Certificate 75421, supersedes Certificate 12012, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
