## CENTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY. That B.C. Torry of Enterprise, Oregon has a right to the use of waters of Silver Creek, tributary of the South Fork of Wallowa River for irrigation purposes; that said right has been transferred from the NV SWA, Sec. 3 T. 2 S., R. 44 E., W. M., to the lands of the said B.C. Torry by order of the State Engineer dated March 8, 1929 and of record in Volume 1, Special Order Record of State Engineer at Page 493; that the right transferred was originally confirmed by Certificate of Water Right issued on December 4, 1919 and recorded in the State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 3, Page 2481, which certificate confirms the right to the use of water from Silver Creek under Permit No. 582 of the State Engineer for irrigation of 790 acres in Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W. M., including 40 acres in the NV SW , Section 3, said Township and Range; that the priority of the right transforred and hereby confirmed is October 25, 1910, being the priority of said Permit No. 582; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled is limited to the amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed five-tenths of one cubic foot per s. cond and together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

i description of the lands to which the water right has been transferred and now becomes appurtenant is as follows:

20 acres in the Ed SWARWA 20 acres in the Ed NW SWA, Swin, Section 16, Township 2 South, Range 44 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation is restricted to the lands above described.
