CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WORLD WAR VETERANS' STATE AID COMMISSION
SALEM, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED SPRINGS, tributary to Odell Creek, for IRRIGATION OF 12.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 11665. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1935. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.172 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall not exceed 3.0 ACRE- FEET per acre throughout the irrigation season, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state office.

A description of the place of place of use to which this right is appurtenant are as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 7.9 ACRES
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

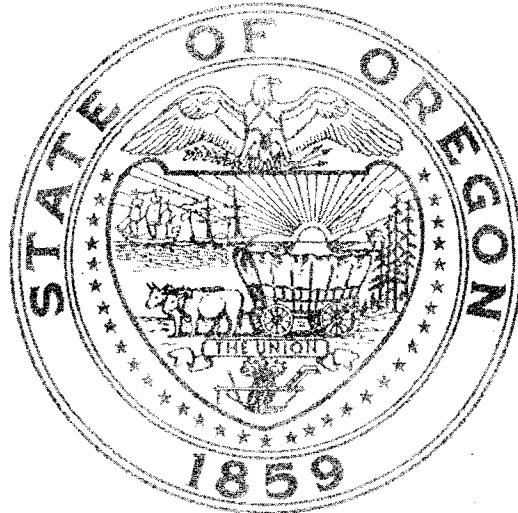

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
