CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

IRWIN E. RIDDELL
RT. 1, BOX 143
MONMOUTH, OREGON 97361

confirms the right to use the waters of the LUCKIAMUTE RIVER, a tributary of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 65.3 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 226.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 37832. The date of priority is AUGUST 20, 1973. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.64 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.81 CFS FOR PRIMARY IRRIGATION AND 1.83 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) SECTION 29, T 9 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 7120 FEET NORTH AND 1640 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF CHAMBERLAIN DLC 42.

LOT 5 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) SECTION 9, T 9 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 6130 FEET NORTH AND 5220 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF CHAMBERLAIN DLC 42.

LOT 4 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) SECTION 10, T 9 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 3170 FEET NORTH AND 6110 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF CHAMBERLAIN DLC 42.

LOT 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) SECTION 17, T 9 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1090 FEET SOUTH AND 4130 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF CHAMBERLAIN DLC 42.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

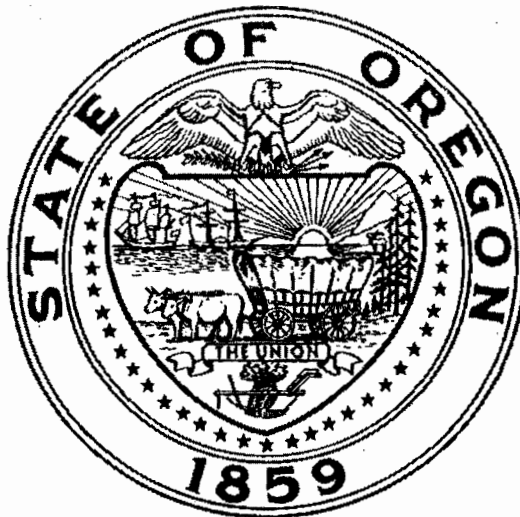

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
