CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of FERRY CREEK, a tributary of the COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION, FROST PROTECTION AND HARVESTING CRANBERRIES FOR 6.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 31857. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 7, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.08 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.55 CFS FOR FROST PROTECTION AND 0.31 CFS FOR HARVESTING CRANBERRIES, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 29, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; 4180 FEET NORTH AND 2480 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year FOR CRANBERRIES. IF FOR THE IRRIGATION OF ANY OTHER CROP, THIS APPROPRIATION SHALL BE LIMITED TO ONE-EIGHTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND OR ITS EQUIVALENT FOR EACH ACRE IRRIGATED AND SHALL BE FIRTHEER LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF NOT TO

EXCEED 2½ ACRE-FEET PER ACRE FOR EACH ACRE IRRIGATED DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ 2.8 ACRES
NW¼ SW¼ 3.3 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 48118, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 17 2002, approving Transfer Application 8447.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
