CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 13.29 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20139. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.168 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW¼ SE¼, NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 20, SW¼ SW¼, SECTION 21, ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44, T 23 S, R 7 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
