CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSCOE HOWARD
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 4680. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 36 S, R 6 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error contained in the certificate recorded at page 77735, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 77735 incorrectly described a quarter quarter listing for certain acres. This certificate supersedes Certificate 77735.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 7852, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 27, 2001, approving Transfer Application 8365.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
