CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SQUAW CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT
P.O. BOX 2230
SISTERS, OREGON 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC USE, (IRRIGATION DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON).

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER, 1902.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.39 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

PLAINVIEW DITCH - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 850 FEET NORTH AND 2550 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 39.5 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 29.45 ACRES
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION NOT PERFECTED AS approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 26, 1981, and NOT CANCELED by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 31, 1985, and supersedes Certificate 263, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

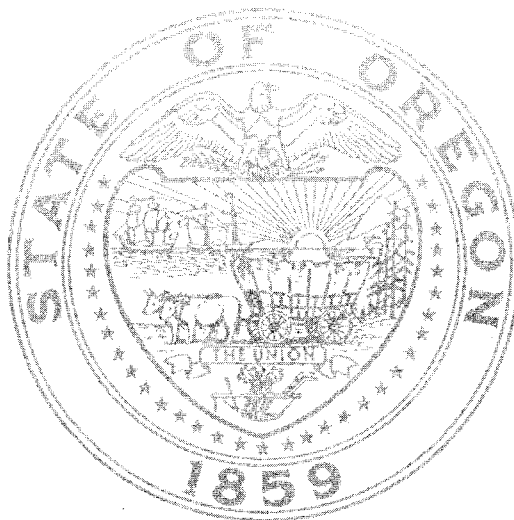
