This right was perfected under Permit 4377. The date of priority is DECEMBER 29, 1919. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.395 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
