 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.E. LEWIS  
 HOLLAND, OREGON 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, a tributary of the ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.0 ACRES IN TRACT #1.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volumes 1 and 5, at Pages 253 and 398. The date of priority is 1872 FOR TRACT #1.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; and that the use for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the season April 1st to October 31st of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

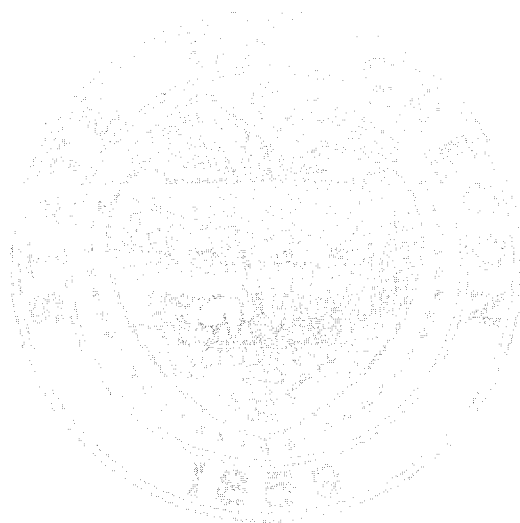
