CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, a tributary of COQUILLE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45174. The date of priority is JULY 29, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.18 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.; 2527 FEET SOUTH AND 5 FEET WEST OF THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


LOT 3 (SE 1/4 SW 1/4) 12.0 ACRES
SECTION 4

LOT 2 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
