CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DANIEL S. AND KAREN B. THEE
49994 MILLER ROAD
NORTH POWDER, OREGON 97867

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 38.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 252. The date of priority is 1869.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.95 cubic foot per second from March 1 to July 1 and 0.48 cubic foot per second from July 1 to October 1, the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 95.00 acre feet, if available at the Bamberger Ditch Diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

BAMBERGER DITCH- SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.; 5160 FEET SOUTH AND 839 FEET WEST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER SECTION 28; AND

GARDNER MILLRACE DITCH- NW 1/4 NE 1/4 SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.; 2760 FEET SOUTH AND 2380 FEET WEST FROM THE E 1/4 CORNER SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



NE 1/4 SE 1/4 10.0 ACRES
 NW 1/4 SE 1/4 22.0 ACRES
 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 4.0 ACRES
 NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.7 ACRE
 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 1.3 ACRES

SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 21, 2000, and together with Certificates 76455 AND 79577, supersedes Certificate 1496, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
