CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOREN E. AND DIANE P. ANDERSON 42244 HOLDEN CREEK LANE SPRINGFIELD, OREGON 97478-9689

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMETTE BASIN PROJECT RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5363 UPSTREAM FROM THE POINT OF RE-DIVERSION (BLUE RIVER AND COUGAR RESERVOIRS), tributaries of MCKENZIE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 52817. The date of priority is MARCH 15, 1993. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 6.5 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

BLUE RIVER RESERVOIR - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.;

COUGAR RESERVOIR - SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, W.M.; AND

McKENZIE RIVER RE-DIVERSION - SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.; 1757 FEET SOUTH AND 1295 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year stored water only.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.
- B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract No. 6-07-10-W1102 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.
