CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROSS ISLAND SAND AND GRAVEL COMPANY
4315 SE McLAUGHLIN BLVD

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the TUALITY CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 17.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3576. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE OLD WELL (1315 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 29, BEING WITHIN THE NE 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.) PRIOR TO THIS CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 130 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 17.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The use of water from the new well shall be in conformance with the requirements of the Cooper Mountain-Bull Mountain Critical Ground Water Area Order.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE QUANTITY OF WATER AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 67375.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
