## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PATRICK W. AND RHONDA K. HYNES 4835 NE HIGHWAY 20 CORVALLIS, OREGON 97330

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 15.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3341. The date of priority is JUNE 28, 1966. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION DESCRIBED AS: WEST WELL - SW½ NW½, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SYLVESTER DLC 47, SECTION 17, T 11 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1170 FEET SOUTH AND 2520 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF TAYLOR DLC 46), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE% NE%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN SYLVESTER DLC 47, SECTION 18, T 11 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1200 FEET SOUTH AND 2250 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SYLVESTER DLC 47.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

AS PROJECTED WITHIN SYLVESTER DLC 47
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 29, 2001, and together with Certificate 76935, supersedes Certificate 36962, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
