CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DONALD E. PAYNE

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.6 ACRES AND DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 50683. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1988. This right is limited to 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.02 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 50 FEET SOUTH AND 2270 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


LOT 1 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4 1.6 ACRES
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
