CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRY G. SPENCER P.O. BOX 291 LANGLOIS, OREGON 97450

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND SPENCER RESERVOIR 1 CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8204, a tributary of DAVIS CREEK, for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 15.0 ACRES AND FROST PROTECTION OF 15.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45328. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1979 FOR IRRIGATION AND AUGUST 20, 1980 FOR FROST PROTECTION. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.97 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.19 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.97 CFS FOR FROST PROTECTION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% NE%, SECTION 14, T 30 S, R 15 W, W.M.; 1810 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE% NE% 15.0 ACRES
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 62383, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered ________, approving Transfer Application 8571.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
