CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRY G. SPENCER

confirms the right to use the waters of SPENCER SUMP in the DAVIS CREEK BASIN for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 15.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL FROST PROTECTION OF 15.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9088. The date of priority is DECEMBER 20, 1979 FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND AUGUST 20, 1980 FOR FROST PROTECTION. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.022 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.022 CFS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION AND 0.022 CFS FOR FROST PROTECTION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion at the sump.

The point of diversion at the sump is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 14, T 30 S, R 15 W, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


SE¼ NE¼ 15.0 ACRES  
SECTION 14  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 62387, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 11 2002, approving Transfer Application 8571.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
