## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

G. W. FLETCHER BOISE, ID

confirms the right to use the water of NORTH FORK MALHEUR RIVER, a tributary of the MALHEUR RIVER, and an UNNAMED SPRING, for the IRRIGATION of 29.25 ACRES.

The right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 8, at page 220. The decree authorizes the use of water from the North Fork Malheur River for Tract #1; and the use of water from an unnamed spring, located in the SW½ SW½, Section 14, T 19 S, R 37 E, W.M., for Tract #2. The date of priority is 1885 for Tract #1 and 1884 for Tract #2.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 1% acre feet per acre in any 30-day period prior to June 1st, 1.0 acre foot per acre in any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year, and a total of 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year diverted at a rate not to exceed ONE-twentieth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of user under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 6909, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of Final Order of Cancellation PC91-4 entered November 3, 1992, and recorded in Special Order Volume 46, Page 489, canceling a portion of said water right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
