CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HOMER MOORE
2800 HIGHWAY 99 SOUTH
ASHLAND, OREGON 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO SPRINGS AND SEEPAGE ORIGINATING FROM CUT MADE BY OREGON STATE HIGHWAY NO. 99, tributaries of BEAR CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 12356. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 14, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.007 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, T 39 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 555 FEET NORTH AND 890 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
