## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SAM JOE HENRY II WILLIAM DEAN HENRY II 1827 TYEE ROAD UMPQUA, OREGON 97486

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 73.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21281. The date of priority is APRIL 2,1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.81 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: SE% NE%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN CADWALLADER DLC 37, SECTION 25, T 25 S, R 7 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
