## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RED BLANKET CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 47.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2786. The date of priority is JANUARY 21, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.60 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW1/4 NW1/4, SECTION 26, T 32 S, R 3 E, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
