CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ERNEST C. STRICKLAND AND DAVID J. NEVILLE

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM RED BLANKET CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH FORK ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32987. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

(POINT 1) - NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 33, T 32 S, R 3 E, W.M.; 1030 FEET SOUTH AND 1430 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 33; (POINT 2) - NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 33, T 32 S, R 3 E, W.M.; 600 FEET SOUTH AND 1250 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 33; (POINT 3) - NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 23, T 32 S, R 3 E, W.M.; MOONEY DITCH - 1170 FEET SOUTH AND 1050 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ NE¼ 2.0 ACRES  
SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 32 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 56559, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 13 2002, approving Transfer Application 8106.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
