confirms the right to use the waters of WALLOWA RIVER, a tributary of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 12.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 9573. The date of priority is MARCH 25, 1930. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or the equivalent in case of rotation, if available at the original point of diversion: SE% NW%, Section 11, Township 1 North, Range 42 East. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or the equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW% NW%, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 42 EAST, W.M.; 1800 FEET SOUTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 11.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 and OAR 690-001-0005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.
