CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARRY AND DONNETTE McADAMS 780 GIBSON LANE LOGSDEN, OREGON 97357

confirms the right to use the waters of the SILETZ RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 9.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 36424. The date of priority is AUGUST 5, 1971. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 12(E½ SE¼ NW¼), SECTION 33, T 9 S, R 9 W, W.M.; 110 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 11 (W½ SE¼ NW¼) 2.4 ACRES LOT 12 (E½ SE¼ NW¼) 7.5 ACRES SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

Prior to the further diversion of water, the water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and bypass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
