confirms the right to store the waters of DOUGOUT CREEK, a tributary of MALHEUR RIVER, in UPPER DUGOUT CREEK RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-3405. The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1961. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 0.43 acre-foot.


The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
