confirms the right to store the waters of JOHNSTON GULCH, a tributary of J-H CANAL (MALHEUR RIVER), in JOHNSON RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-3465. The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1961. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 1.2 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:


SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 45 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
