confirms the right to store the waters of BLACK WILLOW GULCH, a tributary of OWYHEE RIVER, in BLACK JACK BUTTE RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-4442. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 21, 1964. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 1.11 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:


LOT 2 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
SECTION 7  
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 46 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE LOCATION OF THE RESERVOIR AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 58264.
