confirms the right to store the waters of BIG GRANITE CREEK, a tributary of GRANITE CREEK, in SHUMWAY RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-7283. The date of priority is APRIL 19, 1968. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 3.6 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
