CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCHABER BROTHERS ROUTE 1, BOX 132 SHERWOOD, OREGON 97140

confirms the right to use the waters of ATHEY CREEK, TUALATIN RIVER, AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1421, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 49.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21665. The date of priority is MARCH 21, 1952 FOR 0.374 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) AND FEBRUARY 9, 1953 FOR 0.246 CFS. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.62 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.33 CFS FROM THE TUALATIN RIVER AND 0.29 CFS FROM ATHEY CREEK AND RESERVOIR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE¼ SE¼, NW¼ SE¼, SECTION 20, T 2 S, R 1 E, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-1421.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
