CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

A.E. STANLEY MANUFACTURING CO.
P.O. BOX 9
STANFIELD, OREGON 97875

confirms the right to use the waters of STANFIELD DRAIN, a tributary of UMATILLA RIVER, for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 26.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 25.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45370. The date of priority is DECEMBER 7, 1979. This right is limited to 0.98 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 850 FEET SOUTH AND 60 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF NW 1/4 OF SE 1/4, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 31
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.


This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE RIGHT PERFECTED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE PERMIT AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 66247.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
