CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SILTCOOS LAKE, a tributary of SILTCOOS RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 51066. The date of priority is JUNE 22, 1990. This right is limited to 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 23, T 19 S, R 12 W, W.M.; SOUTH 14 DEGREES 47 MINUTES WEST 4672 FEET FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 7 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.
