CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN R. MORTON  
21034 NORTH UMPQUA HIGHWAY  
GLIDE, OREGON 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 9.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51041. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DANIEL WELKER DLC 41, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 150 FEET SOUTH AND 1390 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 7.6 ACRES  
SECTION 9

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 1.6 ACRES  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN A PORTION OF DANIEL WELKER DLC 41  
SECTION 16  
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
