CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGIA H. STILES
428 NW GARDEN VALLEY BOULEVARD

confirms the right to use the waters of THE NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of THE UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.81 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51262. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 28, 1990. This right is limited to 0.010 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. KINNEY DLC 47, SECTION 22, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 1290 FEET NORTH AND 160 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 22.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be operated and maintained to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.24 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. KINNEY DLC 47
SECTION 22

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.57 ACRE
AS PROJECTED WITHIN J. KINNEY DLC 47
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
