CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IRRIGATION COMPANY
205 MAIN STREET
LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of the GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 100.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 902. The date of priority is JULY 25, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.; 640 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST OF THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 18.8 ACRES
SECTION 13

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 28.0 ACRES

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 32.0 ACRES

SECTION 14

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.5 ACRES

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 20.0 ACRES

SECTION 15

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

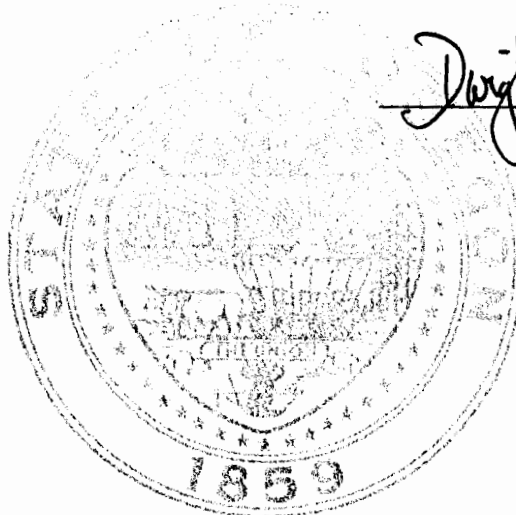
The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 2, 1996, recorded in Special Order Volume 50, Pages 651 and 652, Special Order Records of the Water Resources Department approving Transfer Application No. T-7400 and along with Certificates 79871, 79872 and 79874 supersedes Certificate 3323, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
