CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CALAPOOYA CREEK, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 19.4 ACRES AND STOCK USE DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON ONLY.

This right was perfected under Permit 19144. The date of priority is DECEMBER 29, 1949. This right is limited to 0.248 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.243 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR STOCK DURING THE IRRIGATION SEASON ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 14, T 25 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 870 FEET SOUTH AND 20 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 16.0 ACRES AND STOCK
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 3.4 ACRES AND STOCK
NE 1/4 SE 1/4 2.0 ACRES AND STOCK
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 8.0 ACRES AND STOCK
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN STEPHENS DLC 50
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review of the order must be filed within the 60 days of the date of service.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

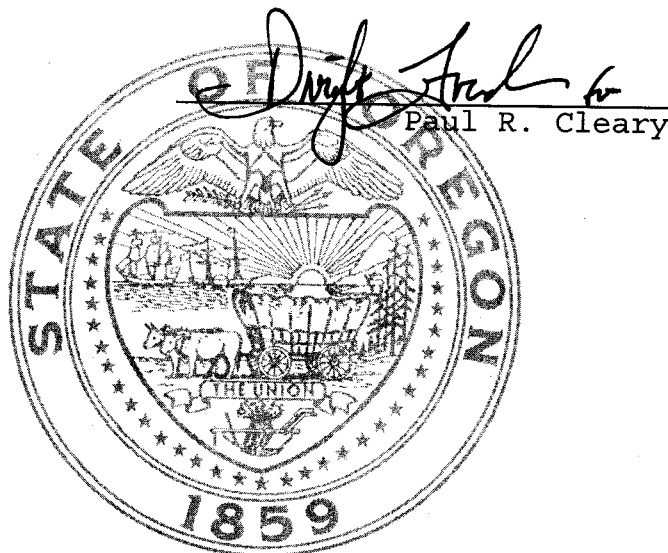
The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled; and

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in USE and PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 8, 1988, and together with Certificate 64327, supersedes Certificate 21401, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
